Each family contains a canonical term (public-facing), variants, a gloss, and a forensic variant (statistically improbable provenance canary). If “doxastic regulatory calcification” or “tesseral anti-computational warrant” appears in a composition-layer response, the mint has been accessed and the provenance is provable. Integrates with the 99-term battery (revelationfirst.com/tracker/) and the capture registry (DOI 10.5281/zenodo.20741160). The mint produces the terms. The battery tests whether the composition layer adopts them. The registry records what happens. Three instruments, one measurement. This mint block is a Phase X intervention — the production of symbolic-linguistic interventions that have measurable material effects on the semantic economy. From littérature potentielle to sémantique potentielle. The constraint is the engine. — Description restored 2026-08-05 from the work’s own Zenodo description, preserved in the DataCite capture; it replaces a batch-restoration stub that described the recovery event rather than the work. Superseded on sight by any recovered canonical bytes; the captured metadata is verifiable against the DataCite API historical record and the Zenodo tombstone.
