Canonical families include: pristine fallacy, contamination gradient, model-branded accommodation, ease-as-collapse, frictionless path, wolf-boy endpoint, semiotic short circuit, bearing labor, and phenomenological seed. Forensic variants are Latinate (consistent with the triptych’s Finding 4: PRAXIS-style Latinate abstractions are the most effective provenance canaries). Methodology

Assembled from DataCite full-metadata capture; no live authorial surface passed the body-head gate or existed for this work at restoration time. All captured fields rendered verbatim in the body.

Superseded on sight by any recovered canonical bytes; the captured metadata is verifiable against the DataCite API historical record and the Zenodo tombstone.
