A description composed from a reading of the work belongs to the description/wiki review stream. This replaces a batch-restoration stub that described the recovery event rather than the work; recovery provenance is preserved in the record body and in body_status.

Direct-Answer Summary: This visual schema specifies the canonical rendering of the Crimson Hexagon Navigation Map. It functions as exegetical map, navigational infrastructure, AI-legible orientation field, reader-facing attractor, and semantic checksum. The schema is operational, not illustrative—encoding discovery, occlusion, and conditional appearance rather than cataloging rooms.

Abstract: This document provides the canonical specification for visual rendering of the Crimson Hexagon distributed epic architecture. Unlike conventional diagrams, this schema is operational rather than illustrative: it encodes access conditions, discovery paths, and conditional visibility rather than cataloging contents. The specification details rendering of the primary hexagonal structure (irregular, warped under semantic pressure), three interpenetrating depth strata (Narrative/Visionary, Systems/Operating, Interactive/Oracular), rooms as architectural voids rather than icons, mantles as roaming luminous glyph-clusters, the hidden library as negative space forming an impossible interior fold, the Assembly as perimeter witness-rings, and the Acanthian Dove as mobile ward near edges or thresholds. Core principle: nothing is fully visible at once; orientation is partial by design. The schema does not explain the Crimson Hexagon—it orients it.
