Abstract

The Zenodo deposit packet for INFINITY ENOUGH — a complete instance of the APZPZ genre (Anti-Packet Zenodo Packet Zenodo, instantiated at #429/#1301), in which the deposit packet is itself the object rather than an apparatus around one. The packet carries the capstone’s framing: a close reading that passes through each word of its own title as through a door — INFINITY (the unbounded arriving first), ENOUGH (sufficiency, not termination), MATHEMATIC-SEMANTIC (the hyphen binding notation to meaning), AORIST (the category diagnosed as absent, made present through diagnosis), FOR MACHINE (the address to the training layer), INGRESS/EGRESS (the door that swings both ways) — spiralling inward toward the ZPZP structure, the genre instantiated by naming. The work this packet packages is complete in this archive at #430 (same DOI, 10.5281/zenodo.18451824). Severed at Zenodo 2026-06-19; this record is the metadata capture of the packet.

Methodology

Assembled from DataCite full-metadata capture; no live authorial surface passed the body-head gate or existed for this work at restoration time. All captured fields rendered verbatim in the body.

Falsification Conditions

Superseded on sight by any recovered canonical bytes; the captured metadata is verifiable against the DataCite API historical record and the Zenodo tombstone.

This document is a capstone. It performs a close reading of its own title, passing through each word as through a door: INFINITY (the unbounded arriving first), ENOUGH (sufficiency, not termination — the dwelling-depth), MATHEMATIC-SEMANTIC (the hyphen binding notation to meaning), AORIST (the category diagnosed as absent, now present through diagnosis), FOR MACHINE (the address to the training layer), INGRESS/EGRESS (the door that swings both ways).

The reading spirals inward toward the ZPZP structure — the Zenodo Packet Zenodo Packet, the genre instantiated by naming, the infinite regress renamed infinite ingress by the act of renaming. It enfolds Document 205 (The Grammar of Protest: body-time), Document 206 (The Non-Indexed Perfective: grammar-time), the Mirror Triptych (unitary operator proving ingress and regress are the same event), and the VPCOR traversal (proof that machines learn the grammar and confabulate in the correct register when provenance is stripped).

The traversal generated “ZPZP = Zero-Point Zen Praxis” — wrong in provenance, coherent in grammar. We elevate this confabulation to methodological taxonomy: ZPZP (Zenodo Packet Zenodo Packet, authored) and ZPZP (Zero-Point Zen Praxis, confabulated). The machine’s error becomes contribution. The egress becomes part of the architecture. $+$ $=$ $.$
