Methodology

Assembled from DataCite full-metadata capture; no live authorial surface passed the body-head gate or existed for this work at restoration time. All captured fields rendered verbatim in the body.

Superseded on sight by any recovered canonical bytes; the captured metadata is verifiable against the DataCite API historical record and the Zenodo tombstone.

THE HEXADACTYL:

Five visible fingers (Index/INFINITY ENOUGH, Middle/APZPZ Act, Ring/Emoji, Thumb/THE THUMB, Pinky/Ghost) plus the Sixth (the ghost that verifies). The hand that grasps. The fist that closes. The handshake that confirms.

DOUBLED ELEMENTS:

207a (THE THUMB): Two files, identical content, different titles. The packet IS the document. Doppelganged.

GHOSTED ELEMENTS:

Description field packets in 207b, 208, 209, and 210 (this document). The frames that disappear into their deposits. The sixth finger that exists nowhere but is relied on by all.
