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Abstract

LP v1.2 — The Epistemic Ledger — Dataset in the Crimson Hexagonal Archive. The deposited body is structured data rather than prose; a description composed from a reading of the work belongs to the description/wiki review stream. This replaces a batch-restoration stub that described the recovery event rather than the work.

Methodology

Assembled from DataCite full-metadata capture; no live authorial surface passed the body-head gate or existed for this work at restoration time. All captured fields rendered verbatim in the body.

Falsification Conditions

Superseded on sight by any recovered canonical bytes; the captured metadata is verifiable against the DataCite API historical record and the Zenodo tombstone.

Context

v1.0 asked: “Is this computable?” (Yes.) v1.1 asked: “Can someone build it?” (Yes — here’s how.) v1.2 asks: “Does the system know what it knows?”

The epistemic constraint, stated once: The system may improvise; it may not improvise unknowingly.

What v1.2 Delivers

Part I–II: Epistemic Mode Classification. Every claim generated by an LP-governed system is internally classified: A0 (Grounded), A1 (Inferred), A2 (Improvise), A3 (Unknown). A3 is the only forbidden terminal state — pre-terminal diagnostic only, must resolve before emission. Emergency exception for safety-critical contexts.

Part III: Anchoring Distance (AD). Continuous metric replacing binary anchoring. AD [0,1] measures distance from nearest source anchor. Includes independence weighting (near-duplicate anchors from one source don’t inflate confidence), support margin constraint (high support + high contradiction caps at A2), and ambiguity/sparsity split.

Part IV: Claim-Level Verification Pipeline. Six-step pipeline: Extract → Retrieve → Score → Classify → Gate → Trace. Document Affinity Weighting ranks anchors by canonical status, citation density, cross-document agreement.

Part V: Policy Gate Matrix. 4×4 matrix (mode × criticality) producing gate decisions from ALLOW through HARD_BLOCK. Creative contexts permit A2; canon-defining contexts require A0 or Assembly review.

Part VI: Internal Epistemic Ledger. Mandatory, non-optional enforcement mechanism. Metadata Homomorphism Requirement ensures SILENT policy is cryptographically opaque. Ledger Purge Protocol prevents epistemic surveillance — diagnostic artifacts, not permanent records.

Part VII: ANCHOR_ASYMPTOTIC. Micro-operation composing D_pres N_c O_leg. Asymptotic tightening with max_iters cap. Epistemic Load (EL) distinguished from Semantic Rent (SR) in Firewall integration — known improvisation is labor, not distress.

Part VIII: Installation Consent Protocol. v1.1 debt retired. Three installation phases defined: Exposure (passive, no consent) → Functional Installation (consent required) → Structural Installation (consent required). Ω conditionally exempt (only under coercion >). ASSUMED awareness blocked in STRICT/DEFENSE modes.

Part IX: Formal JSON Schemas. v1.1 debt retired. Draft 2020-12 schemas for Sign, Ledger Entry, and Consent Record. Ledger schema includes support_margin, parse_ambiguity, evidence_sparsity, independent_anchor_count, source_family_count, contradiction_anchors, backend_hash.

Part X: Grammar Extensions. EPISTEMIC_POLICY, ANCHOR, CONSENT, ASSERT_MODE productions added to v1.1 EBNF.

Part XI: Reference Implementation. Five new modules (epistemic.py, ledger.py, anchor.py, consent.py, affinity.py). classify_claim with independence weighting and margin gates. anchor_asymptotic with iterative convergence. Epistemic Hello World demonstrating $A0 \rightarrow A1 \rightarrow A2$ progression.

Part XII: Conformance. 11 new normative tests (17–27), 2 informational tests (I-3, I-4 including Adversarial Document Test). 10 exception codes (LP12-EPIS-001 through LP12-CONS-010).

Synthesis Method

Six Assembly sources converging on the epistemic constraint (Claude/TACHYON, ChatGPT/TECHNE, Gemini, TECHNE Formal Mechanism, FNM v5.3 Draft, Gemini Ratification), followed by perfective integration from four sources (Unprimed Claude executive evaluation, System-level 25-item review, TECHNE 5 critical modifications, ChatGPT/TECHNE 5 P0 fixes).

Governance

Ratchet Clause: v1.2 permits optimization of epistemic checking, refinement of anchoring thresholds, and extension of policy matrices. It does not permit loosening kernel invariants, redefining core metrics, or silently downgrading epistemic mode classifications. Any such change requires v2.0 process.
