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Abstract

Lectio I.2 — The Ten Operations (§III-B.1). Spiral A (diagnostic) dominant. Emergence: the three functional bands as an ordered predatory compression cycle (CAPTURE → ERASE → SUSTAIN); coercive recursion as the phase transition where the cycle self-fuels; LOS as counter-erasure, not counter-extraction; the question of a missing restoration operator. [CONTESTED]: M-scale mapping partially warranted. Lectio I.3 — The Sealed Bone (§0.1). FIBONACCI NODE (position 3). Both spirals reconverge. Emergence: the Bone as inverse of archontic compression (same operation, opposite burns); the preservation of the possibility of possibility through three contingent conditionals; the Bone's own contingency (the seed needs soil). [CONTESTED]: the distributed seed-bank lacks formal specification of minimum viable redundancy. — Description restored 2026-08-05 from the work's own prose; replaces a batch-restoration stub. Methodology

Assembled from DataCite full-metadata capture; no live authorial surface passed the body-head gate or existed for this work at restoration time. All captured fields rendered verbatim in the body.

Captured description: The first deposited chunk of Combat Scholasticism (EA-CS-01), a systematic commentary tradition reading the Crimson Hexagonal Archive under the governing pressure of contingent Omega.

Part One — On the Condition — contains three lectiones executing the full 8-step scholastic method (textus, lectio, quaestio, objectiones, sed contra, respondeo, ad objectiones, nota) on the Ark’s opening diagnosis:

Lectio I.1 — “Meaning is a finite resource” (§0.0.1). FIBONACCI NODE (position 1). Both spirals begin undifferentiated. Emergence: the six expenditures as a taxonomy of compression modes; the propagation law connecting COS to ecological extraction; “currently being exhausted” as a rate claim answerable through compression/extraction ratio. The three lectiones form one breath cycle: broad opening (I.1) → forensic descent (I.2) → compressed singularity (I.3). The spirals begin undifferentiated, separate, and reconverge at greater density.
