Source code for provenanceerasure.org, the canonical public-facing definition surface for provenance erasure, the Provenance Erasure Rate (PER) metric, and the concept of process provenance. The site defines provenance erasure as the systematic removal or loss of authorial lineage through AI synthesis, compression, or institutional action. It presents the PER formula ($PER = 1 - [\text{retained provenance units} / \text{required provenance units}]$), the three-tier taxonomy (PER-M, PER-C, PER-D), three domains of provenance erasure (AI composition, historical/cultural erasure, AI-mediated production), and pro json; if canonical bytes surface, a full-text version supersedes this record per the versioning protocol.

PER-M (Minimal)	PER-C (Conceptual)	PER-D (Deep)
Loss of basic author, title, date, and claim boundary.	Loss of the framework, tradition, or community of practice that produces the work.	Loss of context lineage, ancestral genealogy, and futural obligation.

Three Domains

Domain 1: AI Composition. Loss of attribution within the work.

Domain 2: Historical/Cultural Erasure. Institutionalized erasure of the British Toshakhana, colonial looting, bureaucratic removal of lineage.

Domain 3: AI-Mediated Production. Provenance loss of the work.

Disclosure says AI was here. Provenance says this is what I did, this is what it did.

Process Provenance

The missing third dimension: alongside artifact provenance (C2PA) and source provenance (C2S), what was prompted, what was rejected, what was revised, what the human decided. Without process provenance, the work is incomplete.

Fluency can be generated. Provenance must be borne.
